Code of Conduct - Troop outdoor activity

The Scout Oath and Scout Law form the basis for the behavior of all Scouts within Troop 152. The Scout Outdoor Code reinforces this for all outdoor activities. Unacceptable behavior will include any action that is deemed unsafe to the scouts and adult leaders at stated activity, as well as any troop and public property. Scouts should initial each item and sign at the bottom along with parent/guardian, to indicate their agreement with these standards. Turn in to trip leader.

___ I agree to conduct myself in accordance with the principles of the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and Scout Outdoor Code.

___ I agree to present myself dressed and properly equipped for the stated activity, and I agree to leave all electronic devices at home (cell phones, i-pods, games, etc.).

___ I agree to be responsible for keeping my campsite, tent, and personal gear neat and organized.

___ I agree to show respect for Troop equipment, public property, the property of others, and I will be personally responsible for the cleanliness and loss or damage of any such equipment and property.

___ I understand that serious or repeated behavior violations may result in my return home prior to the end of the stated activity. If my conduct requires return home, my parents/guardians will be required to provide transportation.
